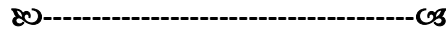


Poetry Exercise 2

Simply Simile

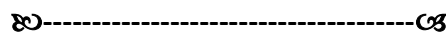
Are you ready to start writing poetry? Here is a simple exercise using grammar to help you on your way! Just follow these 5 steps.



- 1) On the first line write a NOUN of your choice.
- 2) On the second line write 2 ADJECTIVES joined by 'and' that describe the noun on line 1.
- 3) On the third line write a VERB and an ADVERB that describe the noun in action.
- 4) Start the fourth line with LIKE or AS followed by a comparison.
- 5) Start the fifth line with 'IF ONLY' followed by a wish.

*The ENGEES student
 Strict and studious
 Studies seriously
 Like someone seeking a certain secret
 If only she'd stop searching and sit and savor the scenery.*
